* Vehicles using an auxiliary power unit or an idle reduction technology unit may be allowed up to an additional 400 lb total in power unit axle weights, gross vehicle weights, or bridge formula weight limits. To be eligible for the additional weight, the vehicle operator must be able to provide written certification of the unit's weight and must demonstrate or certify that the unit is fully functional at all times. Lift axles or variable suspension axles are allowed on the driver axle group of the power vehicle but may not be used for calculation of legal allowable weight.
