<b>WIDTH:</b>	102"
<b>HEIGHT:</b>	13' 6"
<b>LENGTH:</b>	
Straight Truck	40'
Bus	45'
Tractor-Semitrailer Combo	No Limit
Tractor-Twin-Trailer Combo	65' *
Semitrailer	53' 6" **
Trailers of Twin-Trailer Combos	28' if trailer was manufactured after Dec. 1, 1982 28' 6" if trailer was manufactured prior to Dec. 2, 1982
Stinger Steered Auto-Transporter Combo	80' (Allowed 4' front and 6' rear overhang)
Drawbar Length	15'
General Overhang Limitations	3' front, rear not stated
Special limitations or restriction	
* Either trailer may exceed the applicable legal length provided overall length does not exceed 65'.	
** Trailers over 53' 6" must obtain a special permit plus have red flags and an overlength warning sign. Trailer may be over 53' 6" as long as overall length does not exceed 60'.	
<b>WEIGHT:</b>	
Single Axle	20,000 lb
Tandem Axle	34,000 lb
Tridem Axle	50,000 lb (provided within a tri-axle group no single axle will exceed 18,000 lb or no tandem axle group will exceed 32,000 lb)
Steering Axle	20,000 lb or the manufacturer's axle weight rating, whichever is less. If the vehicle does not have a plate attached by the manufacturer providing the axle and gross weight ratings, then the max weight allowed is 12,000 lb.
Gross Vehicle Weight	80,000 lb (Federal Bridge Formula)
