75' for same combination if distance from steering axle to rear drive axle does not exceed 24', kingpin is at least 5' behind rear drive axle of motor truck, and the distance from kingpin to rear axle of semitrailer does not exceed 34' (36' to rear axle of a triple axle semitrailer). The load upon the rear vehicle of the combination must not extend more than 6'6" beyond the

When combination length exceeds 75', the load must be confined within the exterior dimensions of the vehicle. To the rear, the load may not extend beyond the last point of support for a greater distance than that equal to two-thirds of the length of the wheelbase. The wheelbase of a semitrailer is considered the distance between the rearmost axle of the towing vehicle an the rearmost axle of the semitrailer.
